RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIRING NAPOLI SHKOLNIK PLLC AS SPECIAL COUNSEL FOR
GROUNDWATER SUPPLY CONTAMINATION

WHEREAS, Various chemicals have been known to contaminate the ground water in many communities in the United States and can negatively impact the lives of many, including the citizens of Millington; and

WHEREAS, Napoli Shkolnik PLLC, as special counsel, proposes to investigate the perfluorinated chemicals (PFC) and/or 1,4-Dioxane contamination of the groundwater on behalf of the City and to seek any possible legal claim against all responsible individuals and/or entities, excluding all governmental and municipal entities; and

WHEREAS, The City Attorney has reviewed the Special Counsel Agreement and concurs in it being an appropriate action for the City on behalf of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, The City will incur no expense from this Agreement since all legal fees and expenses will be deducted from any possible settlements or awards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Millington, Tennessee, that the Special Counsel Agreement with Napoli Shkolnik PLLC, a copy of which is attached hereto, is approved and may be signed by the Mayor or City Manager.
