#### At the Historic USA Stadium Complex

Home to USA Baseball from 1986-1996, the stadium has hosted 26 national championships, 18 foreign national teams, 16 NJCAA Division II World Series, 18 Service Academy Classics, 4 TSSAA High School State Championships, close to 400 former and current major league players and more than 40,000 college, high school, foreign and Olympic players who came to Millington to play baseball at USA Stadium.

Today USA Stadium hosts the finest caliber amateur baseball events in the country. It is home to Southwest TN Community College Baseball and a variety of collegiate events throughout the season. With over 50 events already scheduled at USA Stadium this year and new ones added regularly, USA Stadium Complex is the place to be in 2014!

February 14<sup>th</sup> marked the opening of the 2014 Baseball season with the Flag City Classic. The tournament, which ran from February 14<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>, featured 16 teams from 7 states. For some of these teams, it was the first time to be on a field this year due to the severe weather conditions in their home state. With the exception of a few weather delays, the Flag City Classic went off as scheduled and was a huge success.
