Fire Prevention


In the safer workplace

- ▶ Store all flammable liquids away from heat in a well ventilated area.
- ▶ NEVER - Smoke while handling flammable substances.
- ▶ Store any oily rags in a metal container with a self-closing cover.
- ▶ Report any faulty or exposed electrical wiring to your supervisor.
- ▶ Turn off and unplug any appliances such as coffee makers and soldering irons at the end of the workday.
- ▶ Smoke only in designated area.
- ▶ To avoid sparking, use brass or plastic containers to transfer flammable liquids.
- ▶ Repair or replace any leaking tanks, pipes or gas lines.
- ▶ Keep flammable materials away from incompatibles, such as acids.
- ▶ Don't let materials pile up in corridors, stairwells and exit lanes.
