

Answers to Quiz questions:

1. Forward lay- You are laying the hose from the hydrant to the pumper
Reverse lay- place the pumper at the hydrant way from operations
2. Shuttling- carries the water to the pumper supplying the water
Relaying- places a pumper at the hydrant pushing water through a supply hose to the other pumper supplying water
3. Class C or red top hydrants
