

Call Type Descriptions

Fire Calls

Fire calls occur in buildings, chimneys, vehicles, rubbish, receptacles, containers, and on land grass.

EMS/Rescue

Calls consist of Emergency Medical Services, rescue, and lock in calls

Hazardous Conditions

Calls consist of the controlled removal of hazardous substances, arched electrical equipment, down power lines, collapsed structures, and overheated equipment

Service Calls

Calls are purposed to maintain safety for citizens and the environment. i.e lock out, smoke or odor removal, assisting the police or other governmental agency... etc

Good Intent

Calls are received by bystanders who report the sight of smoke motor vehicle accidents, and authorized controlled burning. Calls also include incidents that were cancelled in route

False Alarm

False alarms can be determined to be caused by malicious activity, malfunction, or self-activated due to a bomb scare

Severe Weather & Natural Disaster

Lightning strikes, tornadoes, and high winds along with other natural events have been reported to cause damage to civilians and/or property

Other

Includes calls that are not included in the other call types
